

Added Animal Guidelines to the current Animal Policy in Bylaws:

HOA Members and tenants within the Sunday Harbor Neighborhood will abide by the following rules related to animals kept on property: (pertaining to types of animals)

- Animals kept on neighborhood properties are limited to personal pets. Animals solely intended for agricultural or business purposes are not allowed.
- Exception to this rule: no more than 6 chickens. Roosters are not permitted due to noise issues.

HOA Members and tenants are responsible for the adequate care and supervision of animals at all times, and this includes: (pertaining to animal care and supervision)

- cleaning up any messes or waste created by their pets around the neighborhood, including one's property of residence and others' properties, as well as roadways and the shared park area;
- managing and preventing significant negative impacts on surrounding neighbors, such as noise, aggression, or pollution;
- pet owners are responsible to ensure that pets do not pose any safety risk to others in the neighborhood, including people and other animals;
- pet owners are responsible to ensure that pets are secure on the property and not creating undue hardship to neighbors by going onto other properties unattended.
